



## CADETS USING THE VETERANS ADMINISTRATION (VA) GI BILL REQUIREMENTS -

- MILITARY TRANSCRIPTS – AS OF 1/8/09 THE VA HAS MADE IT A REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE MILITARY TRANSCRIPTS TO THE SCHOOL ATTENDING, FOR THE VETERAN FILES. PLEASE REFER TO SEPARATE SHEET TO REQUEST YOUR MILITARY TRANSCRIPTS. \*THIS DOCUMENT IS REQUIRED BY ORIENTATION DAY.**
  - YOU WILL NEED TO EMAIL THE TRANSCRIPTS TO [ACADEMY@AACOG.GOV](mailto:ACADEMY@AACOG.GOV) OR BRING THEM IN ON ORIENTATION DAY
  
- POST SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS (ANYTHING ABOVE HIGH SCHOOL) – THE VA REQUIRES TO HAVE ON FILE.**  
**\*THIS DOCUMENT IS REQUIRED BY ORIENTATION DAY.**

- DD-214 (NORMALLY SUBMITTED ON DAY OF BPOC ENTRANCE EXAM)**

## MILITARY TRANSCRIPTS

As of 1/8/2009 the Veterans Administration (VA) has stated that the following documents must be in all Veteran files:

1. DD-214
2. Military Transcripts
3. Transcripts from all post-secondary schools (anything above high school).
